Delivery of library materials is available for homebound residents of Polk County who are physically unable to visit the library due to illness or disability. By participating, you may receive up to 12 library items a month, delivered to your residence.

The library does not charge overdue fines on materials checked out through this program. However, you are responsible for the care of library materials and for ensuring they are available at the scheduled pickup time and location. If you lose or damage materials, you will be charged the cost of the item. You must have a library card in good standing to receive services.
