Upon request, library staff will provide available background information on items owned by the library, and reference information related to copyright and fair use principles. This is not legal advice and it is the customer's responsibility to determine the appropriate use of an item. It is the customer's obligation to determine and satisfy copyright or other use restrictions when copying, publishing or otherwise distributing materials from the library collections. Any responsibility for the consequences of copyright infringement lies with the customer.
